Trip planning guidelines:

1. The USS Hornet Museum is open 10:00am – 5:00pm daily. Schedule your visit to arrive no later than 1:00pm and plan on spending 2-3 hours onboard the ship.
2. School groups work best when there is one adult for every 4 children. *HORNET requires a minimum of one adult for every 8 children.*
3. Ample free parking is available across the street from the pier.
4. You may bring bag lunches to eat in a designated area on the ship, or box lunches can be ordered through the Education Department when you make your reservations.
5. Souvenirs are available for purchase in the Ship's Store. Please, no more than 10 students at a time.
6. For groups over 50, additional docent fees may apply.
7. For safety reasons, no large backpacks are permitted onboard the ship.
